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Rules of Engagement

1. Only brews made using the listed (see opposite page) Brew House base kits are eligible. For each entry enter the applicable beer kit & beer style.
2. An entry consists of two (2) 300 to 500ml unmarked beer bottles with plain or blacked out caps, a \$5.00 entry fee and the filled out entry forms. Make cheques payable to:
Edmonton Homebrewers Guild.
3. Attach an entry form (see left) to each bottle with an elastic band. **DO NOT TAPE THE ENTRY FORMS TO THE BOTTLES.** Bottles cannot be returned! Plastic and swing top bottles are acceptable.
4. Enter as many kits as you wish. You may put in more than one entry per kit if brewed to a different style. For example you can enter both a Cream Ale and a modified American Brown Ale using the Cream Ale kit as a base.
5. All entries must specify the base Brew House Kit and the style you made from it. Acceptable styles are listed under each kit. Each entry will be judged based on the style indicated. Entries not categorized as above will not be judged.
6. A special award from the EHG will be awarded for Best of Show-Best Brew House Brewer.
7. Prizes will be awarded for the top beers in each category using each of the base kits.

8. Check the EHG website www.ehg.ca for updates.

9. Judging will be performed by qualified judges under the Beer Judge Certification Program (BJCP). Everyone who enters will have a judging form returned to them for each entry within 14 days of the end of the competition.

10. The EHG reserves the right to expand or collapse any of the beer style classes to make this competition fair and manageable.

11. Results will be posted on the EHG website within 48 hours of the competition close.

12. Creativity is encouraged! For advanced brewers wanting to brew to a BJCP style an “Open” category has been added. Here you can hack or modify your kits. Beers will be judged on closest to BJCP style indicated by the entrant. Entries not indicating a BJCP style will not be judged.
